



*Roll crimp the case mouth into the cannelure.

*The Barnes #42920 200-grain XPB bullet (not the 200-grain #42921) is intended for use in the .44 Remington Magnum cartridge. The cannelure position and design of the X-cavity on the #42920 bullet are tuned specifically for the .44 Rem Mag, while the #42921 bullet is intended for use in the .44 Smith & Wesson Special cartridge.

*Most all .44 Remington Magnum handguns have barrels with a 1:20" twist. However, some older rifles chambered for this cartridge are rifled with a 1:38" twist, and will not stabilize 225-grain XPB bullets.
